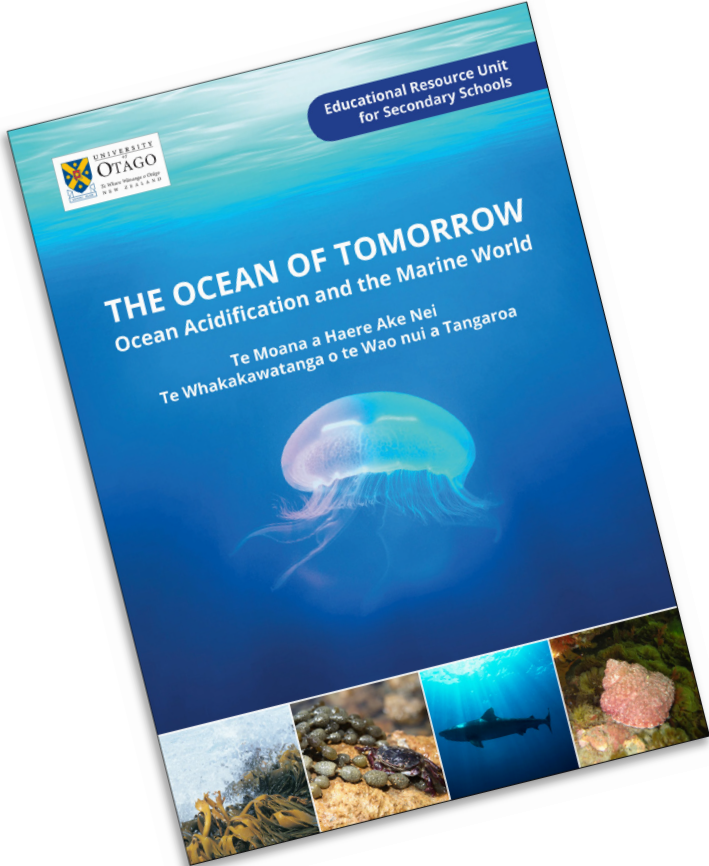




Ocean Acidification Resource for Secondary Schools
